Glass 1/2 Carafe Bottle

Chardonnay by Canyon Road Winery in Modesto, CA

Medium-bodied white wine with notes of crisp apple and ripe citrus fruit with a hint of cinnamon spice.

Pinot Grigio by Canyon Road Winery in Modesto, CA

This medium-bodied white wine has hints of green apple, citrus, white peach and floral blossom. Crisp, the Pinot Grigio leaves a refreshing and revitalizing finish on your palate.

Moscato by Canyon Road Winery in Modesto, CA

This wine has inviting notes of peaches and honey, followed by lusciously sweet flavors of ripe pears and lemons. The slight liveliness amplifies the sweet fruit aromas and flavors.

White Zinfandel by Canyon Road Winery in Modesto, CA

This wine is a light-bodied with hints of strawberry, cherry, and watermelon flavors and a smooth crisp finish.

Full-flavored with aromas enhanced by careful aging in oak casks. Delicate hints of citrus with a long, crisp finish.
